

ARKADOS INC. ON TARGET FOR FISCAL YEAR

NORTH PLAINFIELD, NJ – December 16, 2004 – CDKnet.com, Inc. (OTCBB: CDKN.OB) announced that its subsidiary Arkados Inc., has received a progress payment of approximately \$500,000 from Leviton Manufacturing Company, Inc., one of the largest North American producers of electrical and electronic products under its co-development agreement with Leviton to create various powerline and multimedia home products.

This \$500,000 payment marks the achievement of a significant goal set by Arkados for its first fiscal year as a CDK subsidiary. This achievement is mirrored in the overall spurring of interest in powerline communications for in-home, in-building, and to-the-home applications, such as Broadband Powerline (BPL) communications.

“In-place partnerships for core manufacturing and strategic customer agreements, such as those with Leviton, provide a foundation to develop a customer base and attain market share of the powerline networking segment,” said the Company’s President, Oleg Logvinov. “Our progress under the co-development agreement with an established company such as Leviton goes a long way in ensuring our future participation and leadership in integrated wireless/BPL segments.”

Recently, powerline communications grabbed headlines as the FCC released its Report and Order (R&O) in ET Docket 04-37, garnering coverage in the New York Times, Wall Street Journal, Time Magazine, and Business Week, among others.

Additionally, a recent report from Precursor Advisors has indicated that powerline communications is at a tipping point, and called the technology “the necessary technological building block” that would allow utility companies to exploit new markets.
